

# Sunderland museum a heritage treasure trove

Located in the community's former public library on Church Street, the building is home to close to two centuries of community heritage

The Sunderland Museum has called the former public library at 14 Church St. home for more than 15 years, yet most people don't even realize the community has one. Curated by members of the Sunderland and District Historical Society, the building is home to close to two centuries of local heritage including a genealogical database of 60,000 names of former residents, including the area's first pioneer families. - Sunderland & District Historical
