






BEAVERTON RIVER MUSEUM

The Beaverton River Museum preserves the history and heritage of Beaverton, and the former townships of Thorah and Eldon. The museum has 4 historic buildings, including an 1840s Stone Jail, and Settlers Log Cabin. The museum's archives holds more than 10,000 artifacts. Wheelchair accessible to the first floor of museum.

Museum features Log Cabins, a L.O.L. Hall, a 1929 CNR Caboose and an 1906 Canadian Northern Railway Station. The 1895 Blacksmith Shop includes a forge, smithing tools, a horse-drawn buggy, cutter, cart, and carpentry tools.



SCUGOG SHORES MUSEUM & ARCHIVES

The Scugog Shores Museum shows what daily life was like in Scugog from the mid-1800s to the mid-1900s. This museum has 11 restored buildings, Ojibway Heritage Interpretive Lands, and heritage flower, herb, and vegetable gardens. Guided tours available Wednesday to Sunday during open season from 10am to 4pm.




UXBRIDGE HISTORICAL CENTRE

The Uxbridge-Scott Museum is located on a 5-acre site that overlooks the beautiful Uxbridge Valley and Oak Ridges Moraine with the purpose of preserving the history of the Township of Uxbridge. The museum has 10 buildings and over 10,000 artifacts and archives. Guided tours available during open season.


